<b>FvH Roadshow: Team meetings, tasters and talks</b>	Short inputs which can look at aspects of LGBTI inclusion within football focusing on issues such as inclusion, participation, banter, language, experiences and so on. <b>Community Foundation Training Workshop</b>	Participants will gain an understanding of LGBTI discrimination and abuse as it relates to football. Participants will be able to identify barriers to participation for LGBTI people and understand how these impact on access to and satisfaction with football. Participants will gain an understanding of how the Equality Act 2010 impacts on the service they deliver and will understand the impact of homophobia/transphobia on the welfare of those involved in youth football & in particular the impact of homophobic/transphobic bullying on younger players. Participants will be able to identify opportunities for challenging homophobia/transphobia and supporting LGBTI engagement. Training involves LGBTI football players.	3 hours (can be reduced to 2 hours)	£250
<b>Grassroots Training Workshop</b>	Participants will gain an understanding of LGBTI discrimination and abuse as it relates to football. Participants will be able to identify barriers to participation for LGBTI people and understand how these impact on access to and satisfaction with football. Participants will gain an understanding of how the Equality Act 2010 impacts on the service they deliver and will understand the impact of homophobia/transphobia on the welfare of those involved in youth football & in particular the impact of homophobic/transphobic bullying on younger players. <b>Managers Seminar</b>	This seminar requires some bespoke preparation on the part of both facilitators and participants. Participants should already have a prior understanding of LGBTI discrimination and abuse as it relates to football. Participants will examine the diversity and inclusion role of the manager and consider ways to ensure LGBTI inclusion, and ways to tackle discrimination and LGBTI-phobia. Participants will also look at their own current policy framework as well as the wider social policy and legislative framework.	2.5 hours	£250
<b>Football v Homophobia Allies Training</b>	This training is mainly for those who identify as non LGBTI. Participants will gain an understanding of LGBTI issues specifically within the football context. Participants will understand what it means to be an ally and explore how to create inclusive behaviours and practices. Participants will gain confidence in how to speak up on LGBTI equality related issues and how best to respond in the face of homophobia.	4.5 hours	£30 per person (5-10 people)  £300 (11-20 people)
<b>Training for Trainers</b>	This is available to enable participants to deliver Training Workshops or FvH Allies Training. This will enable clubs or organisations to roll out the training above, or to develop inhouse training or to incorporate LGBTI specific material into internal training.	Full day	£45 per person. <b>Building Bridges Workshops</b>	Building Bridges workshops are particularly targeted where there has been disciplinary action taken, or where there is a need for behaviour change around issues of LGBTI-phobia. Participants will gain an understanding of LGBTI discrimination and abuse as it relates to football. Participants will be able to identify barriers to participation for LGBTI people and understand how these impact on access to and satisfaction with football. The training will include trained LGBTI people who have experiences in football and participants will be expected to create action plans to develop their learning.	3 hours	£300
<b>School Assemblies &amp; Workshops (primary)</b>	Our assembly explains what homophobia is and explores how inclusion can make sport fun for everyone. It highlights how pupils can be role models for inclusion within their own schools.  Our workshop helps pupils understand what homophobia is and how it impacts everyone. It raises awareness of homophobic name-calling, language and bullying and highlights how being a good team-mate can make sport inclusive and fun for everyone.	20-60 minutes	£100-£150
<b>School Assemblies &amp; Workshops (S1-S4)</b>	Pupils will explore key questions such as 'Who is sport for?' and 'Why do many LGBTI people feel unwelcome in sport?' Pupils also explore language that can be hurtful to others and have the opportunity to discuss stereotypes in sport and wider society.	20-60 minutes	£100-£150
